- ENTRIES:** The birthdays and registration will not be handled by the sale. All goats will show by weight, but does will show against does.

FAQ

- Goats will be paint branded.
- Goats show by weight and sex. At least three different classes. Scales will be provided for you to weigh your own. Perfect weight is not the concern. We are weighing to insure that as we sell groups of goats that they will be somewhat comparable in size to insure a smooth flow to the auction.
Example:
Round 1 will consist of the Grand and Reserve Grand Goat, Grand and Reserve Grand Doe,
Class 1—1st through 5th places, Class 2—1st through 5th places, Class 3—1st through 5th places.
Round 2 will consist of 6th through 10th places of each class and so on. This will eliminate the need for ages.
- We will show goats quickly and the judge's decision is meant to set an order that will make the auction flow smoothly. It is not my concern to determine the difference between 9th and 10th. We are only judging them to get the top animals up so buyers will not wait and hold their money for a great one that sells at the end.
- During the auction, I would like to have a least five to ten goats lined up waiting to go in the ring. This insures buyers the chance to make another decision once the animal they wanted sold to another person.
- Booth Space Available at no charge.
- Ag Youth is running full-page ads as well as having the information posted on our website promoting the Ag Youth Goat Sale. Flyers will be posted at many events.

- Ag Youth Magazine Summer and September issues will have an advertisement for sale and the early consignors.
